#### THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

#### Attire

- Proper show attire is required for all classes. Collared shirt required for jumpers.
- Helmets must be worn while mounted. The USEF requires <u>all riders</u> to wear USEF approved head gear.

#### Classes

- Show will be conducted under NIHJA and USEF rules.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if necessary.
- Horses shown in classes not entered or entered at the gate will be charged a \$15 penalty fee in addition to the regular class fee.
- Trophy and six ribbons awarded in each class. Championship and reserve awarded in all divisions. You must be entered in the entire division to be eligible for championship and reserve points.
- Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. Multiple rides will be given consideration. A one minute call will be placed on an open gate.
- In order to add or scratch classes, an official add/scratch form must be filled out and delivered to the show secretary's office.
- Please observe the dotted line on course when making courtesy circles.

#### Stalls

- Stalls are permanent 10' x 12' or vinyl 10' x 10' with doors. Because of the cost
  of manure removal, first bedding is not included. Shavings must be purchased
  from horse show management at \$9 per compressed bale.
- Stalls will be available after Noon on Thursday.
- All stalls cancelled after 9 a.m. on Monday before the show will be charged to trainers.

#### Schooling

- Thursday noon to 7 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday to 1 hour before start time. No schooling in Rings Sunday.
- A warm-up area is available during the show. In addition, a warm-up class will remain open all day. Fence heights will change as show progresses through each day.

#### Miscellaneous

- No smoking in or near any building!
- A charge of \$50 will be made for returned checks.
- All dogs must be on a leash. Please leave dogs at home if possible.
- Annual negative coggins & proof of flu/rhino vaccine required with all entries.

## THE PINGREE OAKS \$1,000 DICK NARTA MEMORIAL CLASSIC

Large Ribbons and prizes 1st through 8th

Prize Money: 1st-\$400; 2nd-\$250; 3rd-\$150;

4th-\$100; 5th-\$50; and 6th \$50

Results for the Classic will be determined by a two-round, combined numerical score. Last round of any Hunter division 2' and higher on Saturday (Friday for professionals) will be the first round of the Dick Narta Memorial Hunter Classic. Be sure to tell the gate when you are doing your first round of the Hunter Classic.

The second round of the Hunter Classic will be held on Saturday. Riders entering this class may choose fence heights at either 2'3" or 2'9". If time becomes a factor, only the top twelve will return for a second round on Saturday. Exhibitors entering this class will declare desired fence height of 2'3" or 2'9" on the entry form. There will be a pinning ceremony immediately following this classic and the top eight places will ride for ribbons.

Classic is open to any horse/rider combination entered in at least one other division on Friday or Saturday during the Pingree Oaks NIHJA show.

### New in 2019

Entries will be accepted online at <a href="https://www.horseshowing.com">www.horseshowing.com</a>
Set up an account and enter your information just once—the software will remember everything for you! This is the same software that the World Equestrian Center (WEC) uses so you may already be in the system. The software charges \$1 per show day to enter online so they will ask for credit card information. For \$25, you can enter a horse for the entire year or pay \$1 as you go (in increments of \$5). So if you plan on attending all 4 NIHJA shows at Fields & Fences, that would be a total of \$12 that you should add to your account.

The software allows you to access class counts, schedules and results from your phone, tablet or computer!
